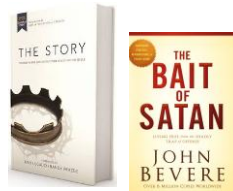

LETTER TO THE AMERICAN CHURCH



Our church is committed to engaging culture to bring Jesus' freedom to lives across all our areas

of influence. To that end, we will be holding a special event **January 27th at 6:30pm at church**, built around a screening of Letter To The American Church (book published September 2022, movie produced in February 2024).

Letter To The American Church is produced by Eric Metaxes in collaboration with Charlie Kirk and others. It is meant to call the modern church to action, raise awareness of parallels between where Germany stood in Hitler's ramp up and where we currently stand in America. Drawing extensively from the life of Dietrich Bonhoeffer, you will see how it's up to us in this unique moment in time. If the German church had mobilized beyond the 1/6th of churches that spoke out, Hitler's power & destruction never could have come to pass.

We will be inviting other churches to join us for this 1-hour film and holding discussion groups immediately following. We will also hear from a variety of fellow parishioners who will be sharing examples of how they have engaged their spheres of influence, from prayer to joining school boards, to simply being in relationship. Not meant to pressure beyond capacity, we can all contribute from whatever is our current circumstance.

Please attend for education, awareness, and inspiration. We are grateful our church leadership is not afraid to call us to engage with culture as Christ's hands & feet, a call to sacrifice.

Two important notes:

- First, this is not meant for kids. You can show the movie at home as you see fit, but it contains sensitive topics and graphic images from recent marches and gatherings.
- Second, this is not about our current President. At all. The film was made prior to the Trump administration and is focused on current culture. Important to note in light of language and accusations currently out in the media and various pockets of society

LEADERSHIP MEETING

December 16, 2025: Leadership Team Notes

Call to Order by Lucas

Present: Pastor Dan Pearson, Lucas Carlson, Jacob Peterson, Matt Thayer, Cary Eastvold, Cindee McBride, Susie Thayer, Doug Lemons, Brenda Cogbill and Emily Johnson.

Devotion and Prayer (led by Jacob). What reward are you looking for based on Hebrews 12:2. The prophets were imperfect and witness to what is coming in Christ. Being a faithful servant doesn't mean being flawless. Look to Jesus the founder and perfecter of our faith—not the outcomes but focus on Him as He will carry you through. He will keep every promise.

Agenda and last month's meeting minutes and Semi-annual meeting. Jacob motioned to approve and Emily seconded for those that as written.

Youth Report. Provided via email from Josh. Reproduced here:

We are in the middle of the "Christmas Break" on Wednesday nights, but we are making the most of it. We've added a new event to our calendar this year by having a game night after the Christmas Caroling which the students that attended are begging we do again next year! Tomorrow night is our CREW Christmas party which the youth very much look forward to each year. We will be resuming our normal Wednesday nights on Jan 14th as we continue to cover challenging questions Christians face. Please continue to keep this in prayer as just in the last month I've had some ground-breaking conversations with students who are struggling with tough situations themselves, or they have shared what their friends are battling and have asked for guidance in helping their friends. The impact the Holy Spirit is making through these conversations is amazing to be a part of.

Coming up, our plans are coming together with the Districts Youth Conference in January. We have 36 students and 6 adults attending this year. This is an event through the Evangelical Free Church and we've joined with East Lincoln Alliance and Apple River Community Church and as a group we are taking down 28 adults and 100 youth!

It's continued to be a challenge coordinating transportation with large groups attending youth events and Bible camp in the summer and with the Fall Youth Retreat. We had 17 students and 3 adults attend the Fall Youth Retreat. (Summer camp had 23 high schoolers). Previous discussion has been had about purchasing another van, but for the amount it would be used, we've started to look at the costs of simply renting when necessary. Would the leadership team approve the renting of 2-15 passenger vans for the Districts Youth Conference, which would allow all of our group to fit into 3 vehicles? Otherwise, Lucas did find an

Escalade stretch limo available for purchase that could possibly work too! :)

Request to rent two, 15 passenger vans. Emily motions to rent Matt seconds. Motion passed unanimously. Current estimate is \$350 per vehicle.

Finance Report. Discussion that if we remove the line for additional staff and/or future building then the financial recovery should be okay. Jacob motioned to accept; Emily seconded. Motion passed with no objections.

Old Business

- Ridgeview Board Meeting (Brenda provided update): Request for prayer overall.
- Facility Update (Lucas provided update): Parsonage. Pastor has moved in but there are still a few things that need to be finished—garage door, some siding, etc.....
- Mission Update (Matt provided update): Met with Kyle Montgomery who is a Missionary in Lebanon. Pastor and Matt met with Emma and Jayden Crim (Slovakia). Hellerstedt family that serves in Cambodia was also recommended. Pastor also recommended Seth and Sam Jordan. It was mentioned that it would be nice to sponsor those connected with The Covenant. Matt stated he is still thinking about a mission trip in 2027. Matt prayed.
- Security Update (Doug provided update): Looking for feedback. There are 3 internal. Dan and Susie state that the internal cameras are meeting needs. Recommend locks and physical security and procedure updates next rather than external cameras. We have a Ring subscription.
- Property Ideas—we should wait.

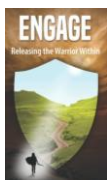
Prayer Time – Tuesdays 8:00 a.m. at church

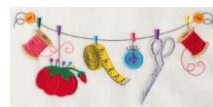

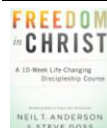
MISSION STITCHERS
