July 7, 2025: Leadership Team Notes

Present: Pastor Dan Pearson, Lucas Carlson, Jacob Peterson, Matt Thayer (left at 7), Cary Eastvold, Doug Lemons, Cindee McBride (via phone), Emily Johnson and Josh Williamson (left at 7:15).

Call to Order by Lucas

Devotion and Prayer. Led by Cary. Psalm 127. Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain. Our efforts to be part of something great and lasting is futile unless the Lord blesses it. If we partner with the Lord and seek him first, he is able to do more than we ask. Cary prayed.

Agenda and last month's meeting minutes. Cary motioned to accept; Matt seconded. Motion passed with no objections.

Youth Report by Josh. Josh met with youth leaders a couple of weeks ago to review the year as to what went well and what needs adjusted. The leaders are great. Making plans for next fall. Looking at some curriculum and also talking with Lynn Pickard for something for CE and something that would go for Wed with adults. Had a river tube and lake day is coming up. Sr High for camp soon and MUUUCE is coming up and we have chaperones for that.

Finance Report. Leadership reviewed the report. No questions. Jacob motioned to accept; Emily seconded. Motion passed with no objections.

Old Business

- Ridgeview Board Meeting: No report. Brenda will continue to attend those meetings.
- Building Team: Church workday email went out today July 8th.
 Cary reporting out. This Friday they will start removing trees
 from the backyard. Saturday there will be a workday for brush
 clearing after men's breakfast. Men's breakfast to be moved
 from the park to the church. The surveyor will be doing a full
 boundary survey later next week.
- Mission Update: there is a board featuring our missionaries.
 Pastor Dan visited KICY when he was in Alaska. There was a team there from Cali.to help. KICY is building a new staff housing unit. They are a little bit understaffed right now. Patty from KICY may come and so there might be another Salmon dinner at the church--very tentative.
- Job Description Review Progress. No update.
- Security. Nothing specific to S.S. tonight. Doug provided the beginning of an outline for general security. Recommendation for a crash bar to make East door egress only in order to keep our nursery safe. Plan reviewed which also included having a single designated door during the week. During Sunday service, staff each outside door. Recommend security awareness training. Doug and Charlie McBride met with Jason Tanner to consult re: any electricity update for outside. Regarding the indoor cameras, is there a concern for recording activity on the inside which would be kept internal? LT agreed probably not as service is already "broadcast." Recommend phased approach to the cameras—starting with the inside. The Internet needs to be upgraded to support the camera system and monitor purchased. Also recommend testing exterior flood light/camera combo. After that go to phase 2. Physical security—latches on the inside that could be set high that the adult in the room could set if needed. Next

- steps: Doug and Charlie to obtain cost estimates which LT will review and then bring forward to congregation. Cost would come out of building maintenance funds.
- Chimney Removal: Kent is addressing this. He has a plan.
- Facility updates: Men's bathrooms need some fixes/updates.
 There is some dry rot outside that needs addressing. A
 recommendation for a separate team of trustees or a
 maintenance committee to address the upkeep of the church
 was made. The leader of that group would present
 needs/activities to the LT. Probably 6 people with set terms.
 Initial terms would be staggered but eventually 3-year terms.
 Lucas will present.

New Business

- Utility shed: Recommendation to tear it down. Do we need it?
 Probably not—most items could be moved to the larger shed.
 May address with Saturday work crew.
- Sound Equipment Decisions. Priority list: video camera, multimonitor output, new computer, new monitor, and miscellaneous cable \$3,218.00. Emily motion to approve \$3300 and Jacob seconded. Motion passed. No objections.

Pastor Dan Items: Gone August 17th (Matt to speak) and on the August 24th (Josh will speak).

- Semi-annual meeting
 - Doug will share about some of the security items
 - Lucas will put the agenda together and send it out
- Mutual Ministry
 - Emily will take the lead to coordinate a touch base.

August 12, 2025: Leadership Team Notes

Lucas called the meeting to order at 6:02pm.

Members Present: Lucas Carlson, Brenda Cogbill, Jacob Petersen, Cay Eastvold, Emily Johnson, Pastor Dan Pearson, Josh Williamson (Left at 6:35pm for the CE leaders meeting), and guest Karen Schnell (left at 6:20pm).

Mission Update: Karen shared a Missions Update about her time with the Tapestries Orphanage in Mexico in January and then an update she received in July. They are primarily working with children in Protective custody due to their past situations. They have room for about 200 kids. Currently they have 40 employees and are primarily donation supported.

Karen also shared that she and Pastor had discussed starting a grief support group, and while there are some details to work out, she has said she will help lead that.

Youth Report: Josh gave the Youth report and discussed that he is gearing up for fall programs. There was a CREW Hangout at Mohrland's last week and at Carlson's this week. All LBBC camp weeks are over now, and Josh said there have been some really amazing testimonies coming from kids that went to camp, and that overall camp did a great job supporting the youth in their faith this summer. Josh and Gretchen Wallberg chaperoned some of the youth to MUUUCE and he said overall things are solid as far as theology and worship, but there were a few concerns with the "fun stuff" the kids could do, He will be sharing with Ginny at the Northwest Conference office to give some feedback. He also

(con't Leadership Team Notes....) shared a Ministry Leader flowchart as we continue our conversations about volunteers and accountability.

Devotional and Prayer: Emily shared a devotional from Philippians 3:13-14 that talked about focusing on God and his will. She shared a prayer for wisdom and focus for our meeting.

Agenda and Last Month's meeting minutes: Cary moved to approve the agenda and July meeting minutes. Jacob seconded and the motion carried.

Finance Report: Financial reports were reviewed. Jacob moved to approve the reports as submitted. Cary seconded and the motion carried.

Old Business:

- Brenda shared an update from the Ridgeview Board. Lynn S will be stepping down from doing the book work and accounting, they will be looking for a new person to do that. They hired Jenny Bergmann to assist with the landscaping.
- Lucas gave a facility update. The parsonage has been lifted, and will be moved to its new location in the next day or so.
- Dougs's security update is tabled to September.
- Lucas gave a church chimney removal update. Kent is all set to go on that, and it will likely be a phased approach. It was unable to happen earlier due to events at church.
- We will be looking to assemble a Team of Facility Trustees to handle the repairs and maintenance of the church.

Pastor Dan items: Discussed ideas for the Wednesday night study for adults. Sunday School adult study is "The Story" curriculum which is a chronological study through the Bible. Discussed starting a senior group.

Lucas closed with prayer.

Jacob Moved to adjourn the meeting, Cary seconded and the motion carried at 7:20pm.

The next meeting is September 9th at 6pm, Lucas will share the devotion.


