CREW is our Jr & Sr High Students (gr 7-12).


John 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

LEADERSHIP MEETING

Leadership Team Meeting December 12th, 2023

Leadership team was called to order at 6 pm Tuesday, December 12th, 2023. Present in person were Lucas Carlson, Mike Pickard, Pastor Dan, Josh Williamson, Susie Thayer, Burt Beebe, Brenda Cogbill and Scott Carnine. Cindee McBride and Terry Silverberg were present via telephone. Lucas called the meeting to order.

Lucas read from Romans 8:35 for a devotional. He opened the meeting with prayer.

Youth Report was provided by Josh Williamson. He stated the youth plan on going Caroling with the church. There is a Christmas Party scheduled. Josh sent out emails to parents to give a heads up about what the upcoming year may look like both per the calendar and possible financial needs. He is hoping that this summer can include a mission trip either just with youth or youth and adults serving either here in the Midwest or further out. There is a parent meeting scheduled January 7th.

Financial reports, agenda and meeting notes were reviewed. Mike motioned, Burt seconded, motion passed to accept all three.

Old Business. There were no survey team updates; because, as previously recommended, the current teams have concluded and there will be an opportunity for people to participate in Stage 2 activities related to survey findings. Brenda reported that the Ridgeview meeting went well as she continues to join on behalf of our leadership team. The nominating committee will be working toward recommending replacements for Mike and Scott as their serving terms come to a close.

New business. Pastor Dan brought forward that the Red Cross has inquired if UCCC would be willing to be a host location for them. Leadership team agreed that as long as the timing doesn't conflict with any church needs, that that would be a nice act of service to our community. New lighting in the handicap parking needs adjustment. There was also discussion regarding the need for a maintenance point person. Cindee inquired about the church hosting an IF women's conference. There was no objection as long as there are point people to lead and coordinate. Cindee will follow up with the women who have stated interest. Terry provided the mutual ministry team report.

Other Business: We planned to 2024 budget, making adjustments as needed, including adding a line for continuing pastoral education and church security needs. Pastor, Susie and Josh left the meeting, and we discussed salaries for 2024.

Mike motioned to adjourn, Cindee seconded, and we adjourned about 8:15 p.m. Next meeting will be January 8th at 6 pm. Scott volunteered to lead devotions.
