PASTORS CORNER

Jeremiah 31:18-20

I have heard Israel saying, 'You disciplined me severely, like a calf that needs training for the voke. Turn me again to you and restore me, for you alone are the Lord my God. 191 turned away from God, but then I was sorry. I kicked myself for my stupidity! I was thoroughly ashamed of all I did in my younger days.' 20 "Is not Israel still my son, my darling child?" says the Lord. "I often have to punish him, but I still love him. That's why I long for him and surely will have mercy on him.

In this passage, the prophet Jeremiah is comparing Israel to a young man who has been rebellious but now sees the folly of his ways. Even though the young man has made poor decisions and gone the wrong way, he now wants to get right with God. The Lord expresses the love and mercy he is willing to show Israel.

We have a God who is full of love, compassion, and mercy. When we stumble and fall, he is waiting to forgive us and show his grace to us. What a wonderful God and Father we have! When we stumble, may we quickly return to him and be restored!






