### LEADERSHIP MEETING

## Leadership Team Meeting February 5, 2024

Present: Pastor Dan Pearson, Terry Silverberg, Brenda Cogbill, Lucas Carlson, Burt Beebe, Tim Jurisch, Josh Williamson, Susie Thayer, Emily Johnson, Jacob Peterson and Cindee McBride.

The meeting was called to order by Lucas at 6 pm. Devotional was provided by Cindee—Psalm 119:105. Lucas prayed. Youth Report: Josh reported that things with the youth are going wonderfully. They are putting ideas together into the fall. Attendance has been great so far this year. We are expecting 50 to 60 kids at the Lock-in and a large group for the "Feed my Starving Children" serve event. This summer the youth are looking at what activities are possible. There is interest in missions. There has been discussion about a Chicago group called "Jesus People U.S.A.

Leadership team officers for this next year are: Lucas as chair, Terry as vice-chair, Cindee as Secretary and Tim as Finance Lead.

Financial reports were reviewed. Tim made a motion to accept, Burt seconded it. Motion to accept passed.

Consent to the agenda and last month's meeting notes was motioned by Burt, seconded by Tim, and passed.

Old Business: Tim reported that things are going well at Ridgeview. All units are occupied. There was discussion about options to explore church building expansion including possibly utilizing National Covenant Properties as a resource. The leadership team agreed that a committee (which will include at least one member from the Leadership Team) will need to be formed and that the first step prior to that is to have an allchurch night of prayer and worship with fasting prior to the corporate prayer time. March 1 at 6:30 was agreed to as the time for the prayer and worship time to seek God's will regarding expansion. In addition, the ask is that the church be in continual prayer regarding stewardship of all God is providing. Cindee shared that rather than doing something with the "IF' women's conference, the team would like to start with a Women's breakfast—more to follow—currently the target date is April 6th.

New Business: CPR certification was brought forth as a need for safety events. This will be brought to the congregation for volunteers. There is a clarification to the budget presented at the annual meeting—the building fund should be broken out as Building Fund =\$53,151.72 and Funds Designated for Parking = \$20.505.94. Due to Solid Rock no longer being offered, the leadership team voted to re-purpose the "Solid Rock" \$700 funds toward Lake Beauty Staff Scholarships. Cindee motioned to approve, Burt seconded, motion passed. The sound quality in the Foyer was discussed—the sound issue is being addressed. There will be two services for Easter. The Leadership Team discussed supporting M.E.N.A missionaries with a gift of \$1200.00 and the Browns with \$250.00. Terry motioned to approve; Burt seconded. Motion passed.

Devotions for the next meeting will be led by Burt. March 11 is the next leadership team meeting.

Emily motioned to close the meeting; Jacob seconded. Motion passed. Lucas closed the meeting in prayer.
